## **CAMPING RULES**

Welcome to the Nittany Antique Machinery Association show. We hope you enjoy your stay with us. We would, however, appreciate your support in adhering to a few rules for everyone's safety and well-being.

- All campers must be registered. The camper registration card you receive must be displayed in the front or side window of the camper. The associated "Camper Vehicle Parking Permit" must be placed in your vehicle at all times and must be clearly displayed on your mirror or dash.
- The importance of registering your camper is such that we can locate you in case of an emergency or others are trying to locate you.
- Only vehicles with "Camper Vehicle Parking Permit" will be permitted to be parked at your camper or admitted to the camping area. All other vehicles must be parked in the appropriate parking lot areas. Tractors are not allowed to be parked in the camping area and need to be parked in their assigned areas.
- Please wait to be placed do not park your camper yourself wait for parking directions by camper parking personnel.
- All campers must be blocked before unhooking from towing vehicle.
- The final decision on all issues relative to the Camping areas are with the Camping Chairperson and his/her decision is final.
- FIRE LANES and ALL roads within the camping area must be kept open at all times for emergency access. This is for your protection and others if an emergency were to occur.
- GENERATORS <u>ARE</u> NOT TO BE RUN FROM 11:00PM TO 7:00AM. Please respect your neighbor. All generators must have stacks on the exhaust to direct exhaust gases above your RV and away from your neighbors.
- NO OPEN FIRES! Fireworks of any type are not allowed on the grounds at any time!
- Wastewater must be stored and cannot be run onto grounds.
- Keep your campsite area clean at all times and place waste materials into the provided receptacles. PLEASE leave your campsite as you found it.
- PETS AE NOT ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS AT ANYTIME.
- PETS <u>ARE ALLOWED</u> IN THE GENERAL CAMPING AREA AS LONG AS THEY ARE IN A PEN/CAGE, INSIDE YOUR CAMMPER OR ON A LEASH THAT DOES NOT EXTEND BEYOND YOUR INDIVIDUAL CAMPING LOT. PLACE YOUR PET ON A LEASH TO TAKE TO THE BATHROOM – OUTSIDE THE CAMPING AREA AND AWAY FROM TRAFFIC AREAS. YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the grounds. Your understanding in this matter is appreciated.
- Foul and abusive language will not be tolerated.
- Abide by requests from Security or camping personnel. Respect your neighbors.
